CHILDREN AND MASJIDS

The Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) said, "Save your masjids from children, insane people, trading, loud voice quarreling and the drawing of the sword." (Ibn Maja)

Children who do not know the masjid etiquette and have no idea of ritual cleanliness and uncleanliness should not be allowed in the

masjid.

The Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) says, "When the child is seven years old order him to perform prayer and when he is ten punish him for

not praying."

It does not mean that when the child is seven years old he can pay due respect to the masjid. If he cannot do so he should not be brought to the masjid. The instructions and training for prayer can be given at home. If a child is seven years old and can show respect to the masjid and understands ritual cleanliness and uncleanliess then he is allowed to come to the masjid.

ENTERING THE MASJID AFTER EATING ONIONS, GARLIC (OR SMOKING)

Hazrat Muawia (R.A) narrates from his father that the Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) forbid from two plants which are onions and garlic and said, "Whosoever eats them should not come near our masjid but if he is going to eat them then he should get rid of the smell by cooking them before hand. "(Abu Dawud)

It is known from this hadith that one is not allowed to enter the masjid after eating something which creates an odour in the mouth.

When someone comes to masjid with an odour in the mouth he will trouble and distract the attention of the person standing next to him in the prayer which will result in him being sinful instead of receiving merits (Thawab). Further to this, Allah's angels who are in the masjids are troubled from people with odours in their mouths, clothes or body.

QUESTION & ANSWERS

The following questions and answers are taken from 'Fatawa Mahmoodia'. The answers were given by Mufti Mahmoodul Hasan Gangohi, who is a great Caliph of Hazrat Shiekhul-Hadith Moulanna Zakaria (R.A.)

Question: Is it permissible for a woman to drive?

The specified place for prayer in the house will not have the same status as a masjid because any Muslim is not allowed to come and perform prayer in that place without the permission of the owner of the house.

The women folk during the course of menses and puerperium (nifas), may make ablution and sit down in that place and remember Allah at the scheduled time of prayer and recite durood, do Istigfar (seek divine pardon fo sins) etc. There by the habit of prayer will be maintained. The women folk can also perform I' tikaf in this place.

WORLDLY TALKS, READING THE QURAN AND DOING ZIKR LOUDLY IN THE MASJID

It is reported by Hazrat Hasan (b.p.u.h) that the Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) said, "A time will come upon the people when their talks in the masjid will be worldly, do not sit with them, Allah has no need for them."

Masjids are built to remember Allah and to recite the Holy Qur'aan. In other words it is to worship Allah. It is not a market or a public park.

The worldly talk that is permissible outside the masjid is not permissible inside, and the talk that is not permissible outside the masjid i.e. backbiting, lying, slandering will be extremely unlawful (Haram) in the masjid it is stated in 'Fathul-Qadeer' that indulging in worldly talks in the masjid obliterates the deeds of forty days.

If a person does not sit down in the masjid to talk about worldly matters but incidently talks about an impotant matter in a low tone then this is permissible. However it is desirable to refrain from this.

To read the Qur'aan loudly or to do zikr loudly is not permissible if it is causing disturbance to another persons prayer or to a person reciting the Qur'aan. (Shami Vol 1 Page 618)

It is a pity that people today are extremely negligent towards these regulations, they do not realise that this loud reading of theirs is disturbing others, despite this they consider their worship as being a work of merit (Thawab).

Similarly some people come and throw their belongings on the floor of the masjid with a bang, whereby the attention of the people indulged in prayer is diverted towards the noise, such an act is forbidden.

Once Hazrat Umar (R.A) was offering prayer when a man came with some belongings and with a loud bang placed them in front of the row and engaged himself in prayer. After finishing his prayer Hazrat Umar (R.A) punished that person and said, "You caused disturbance to other people's prayer."

We Muslims should ask ourselves as to how much we are abiding today to the rules concerning masjid and how lax we are with regard to this

When a person leaves his house to go to the masjid he should recite:

اللهم انی اسئلک بحق السائلین علیک و بحق ممشای هذا فانی لم اخرج اشرا ولا بطرا ولا رہاء ولا سنته و خرجت اتقاء سخطک وابتغاء مرضاتک فاسئلک ان تعیننی من النار و ان تغفرلی فنوبی اندلا یغفرالننوب الا انت

O Allah! I ask thee on behalf of the rights of the supplicators upon thee annd on behalf of this walk of mine, for I have not come out in pride, nor boastfully, nor to be seen of men, nor for fame, but I have come out To save myself from thy anger and to seek thy good pleasure. I ask thee that thee save me from hell and pardon my sins, for non grants pardon from sins save thee.

While going to the masjid, one should walk with patience. He Should not run to engage himself in useless things.

THE SUNNAH METHOD OF ENTERING AND COMING OUT OF THE MASJID

Hazart ibn Umar (R.A) used to first put his right foot in the masjid when entering and while coming out he would first take the left foot out.

When entering the masjid one shluld send blessings upon the Prophet (P.B.U.H) and then recite:

اللهم التحلي أبوأب رحمتك

"O Allah open for me the doors of thy mercy

It has been narrated regarding some of the past saints that when they used to enter the masjid their faces used to turn yellow because of fear. Someone asked the reason for this The saint replied, "When you go the the royal courts, some kind of fear overcomes you and you make sure you do not do anything which is against the law or respect of the judge or the kings. So should we not have respect and fear of the creator of the courts and kings more than the creation."

It is stated in a Hadith of Mishkat that when one enters the masjid it is praisworthy to perform two rakats of prayer before sitting down.

They are known as Tahiyyatul Masjid.

When coming out of the masjid one should first take the left foot out and recite:

اللهم اني استلك من فضلك

'O Allah I beg Thee of Thy grace.'

MASJIDS IN THE HOUSES

Hazart Aisha (R.A) says, "The Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) gave order to specify a place for prayer in the house and ordered that the place be cleaned and perfumed."

perform I 'tikaf in the masjid, Islam is spread from a masjid. This person will receive the reward for all these good deeds that are performed in a masjid. Some scholars have said that if a man cannot afford to build a whole masjid, he can share the recompense by donating a sum of money.

THE MASJID IS A GARDEN OF PARADISE.

It has been reported from Hazrat Abu Huraira (R.A) that the Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) said,

"When you pass through the gardens of paradise graze to your hearts content."

The compannions asked,

"O Prophet of Allah! What are the gardens of parardise?"

The Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) replied,

"The masjids."

The Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) was asked,

"What is the meaning of grazing?"

The Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) answered

"Subhanallahi Wal Hamdu Lillahi .Wwala Ilaha ..Illallahu Wallahu Akbar.' (Mishkat page 70)

It is understood from this hadith that masajid are gardens of paradise from which one can obtain fruits without any obligation. Also it is understood that the fruits of the gardens if 'Subhannallahi Wal Hamdulillahi Wala Ilaha Illallahu Wallahu Akbar'. It is not necessary that only the zikr mentioned above be recited.

One can recite any zikr or perform superegatory (nafl) prayer. How ever, the Zikr should be recited in a very low voice so that a person who is performing prayer is not disturbed.

THE ETIQUETTE AND VIRTUE OF GOING TO THE MASJID

The royal courts and courts of law in this world have their own particular etiquettes which have to be adhered to when attended, Similarly the masjid which is the court of Allah, who created the kings and rulers, has its own etiquettes which have been taught by the Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H).

Whenever you think of going to the masjids, first make your body

and clothes clean, perform ablution and then go.

Once the Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) asked, "Should I not inform you of an act by which Allah will pardon the sins and enhance the status?" Those present replied, "Certainly, O Prophet of Allah."

The Prophet (P.B.U.H) said,

"To perform ablution properly even though one finds it loath some, to go frequently to the masjid and to sit waiting for the next prayer after (performing) a prayer. This holds the same rank and status as safeguarding the border." (Muslim)

of Allah Muhammad S.A.W said to us the same thing what they were doing at the Earth Summit. He said "THERE ARE SOME PEOPLE TRAVELLING IN A SHIP THAT HAS TWO LEVELS. It is related by Abu Dharr Ghifaari (R.A) that the Apostle of Allah (P.B.U.H) said: "He became fortunate and successful whose heart Allah set aside for faith and made it safe and sound [i.e., whom He blessed with faith so pure and untainted that not an iota of doubt or hypocrisy could enter his heart and protected it against the spiritual maladies like envy and ill will, and whose tongue He endowed with truthfulness, and in most self with serenity [i.e, Whose soul was such that it derived solace from the remembrance of Allah and the things that were pleasing to him], and whose natural disposition He put right and free from weaknesses [so that it did not tend towards sin], and whose ear He made fit to hear and eyes He made fit to see [i.e., who could hear the truthful word of Allah and see His signs and take warning and draw lessons from them] Thus, the ear is like the funnel [Through which things go into the heart as the liquid is poured into a bottle], and the eye is the conveyor and stabilizer of things which it entrusts to the heart. And blessed, indeed, is the man whose heart the Lord made capable of remembering."

Commentary

What has been said about the ears and eyes in the concluding part of the above Tradition is to underline the importance of the part the two organs play in the life of a man. Whatever reaches the heart which, so to speak, is the monarch in the human body, and affects it, is generally, through the ears and the eyes. Consequently, the success and salvation of the bondsman is dependant on the ability and fitness of his eyes and ears to see and hear.

The last sentence denotes that even though the things of success and good fortune reach a man's heart through the eyes and ear, salvation and felicity in the Hereafter cannot be attained unless the heart is capable of preserving and making proper use of them.

In the Qur'aan the three faculties of seeing, hearing and understanding have been mentioned, from place, in a way as if man's guidance and deliverance was contingent on their soundness.

Amr Ibne Maymoon Awdi reports that the Apostle of Allah (P.B.U.H) said to a man while he was admonishing him:

"Realise the value of five states before the other five states come to pass and make full use of them:

- (a) Realise the value of youth before old age:
- (b) Realise the value of health before you fall ill;
- (c) Realise the value of wealth before poverty sets in;
- (d) Realise the value of leisure before occupation; and
- (e) Realise the value of life before death.



7. He taught man the use of pen and imparted him the knowledge which he could never attain to without the benevolence of God.

LESSONS FROM HADEETH

Some Important Exhortation of the Prophet sallallahu alayhi wasallam By Maulana Manzoor Nu'maanni

It is related by Abdullah Ibne Amr (R.A) that the Apostle of Allah (P.B.U.H) said: "Four things and habits are such that if you possess them then there is no harm if the world [and its blessings] are lost or do not come to [your] hand. [These are]:

(1) safe-keepinng of trust; (2) truthfulness in speech;

(3) good manners; and (4) caution and abstinence in food"

Commentary

The word 'trust' is used in a very wide sense in the terminology of Islam. It includes the fulfilment of the rights of Allah and of men as well as the carrying out of covenants annu promises. Thus, a person who is trust worthy, i.e., who fulfils the rights of Allah as well as of men honestly and is truthfl when he speaks and possess good manners and noble qualities of mind and character and exercises self-restraint in food and drink and does not over eat or partake of things that are forbidden or of a doubtful nature is, positivly a very fine specimen of humanity. He is not only a perfect man in this world but in the neverending life of the hereafter, too. Such exceptional favours will be conferred upon him that each one of them will be more valuable than all the blessings of the world put together. If a man like him remains poor in the earthly existence, he should not grieve for what he has is far superior to all that the world has to offer.
