PROGRAMME

The objectives of the World Islamic Forum will be considered at an International Seminar, being held on 15 August 1993 at **CONWAY HALL**, Humanist Centre, 25 Red Lion Square (near Holborn Tube Station), **LONDON W1.**

Distinguished scholars of the Islamic World and Muslim intellectuals from England will participate in this seminar, which will mark the beginning of the functional activities of the Forum. It is also intended to inaugurate the London Head Office on this date. The first sitting of the World Islamic Forum was held at Gujranwala on 29 April 1993. The burning issues of the Islamic World are discussed at these meetings, scheduled to take place in London from mid June 1993. Top - Class scholars of different schools of thought and intellectuals will be invited to express their views.

IDEOLOGY

Members of the World Islamic Forum belong to Ahlussuna-Wal-Jama'at. Their ideology is based upon the teaching and thoughts of Shah Whli-Ullah.

The World Islamic Forum acknowledges all theological groups. Publicity in any country will reflect this with the aim of being in accord with majority views.

The Forum acknowledges the contemporary need and importance of "Ijtihad" (Judgement in legal or theological questions), in accordance with the Usul-i-Ijtihad of the four Imams, Imam Abu Hanifa, Imam Shaafi, Imam Malik and Imam Ahmad Bin Hanbal. The
