ABSTRACT

The exegesis of the Holy Qurā'n is subject to specific rules of interpretation derived from Arabic language and other sources. The exegetes have been using several qirā'āt-e-mutawatirah as an interpretive tool. Besides these qirā'āt-e-mutawatirah there is a type of qirā'āt named qirā'āt-e-shadhdha which has a considerable impact over the Qur'anic exegesis. This article aims to study different features of this type of qirā'āt and their impact on Qur'anic interpretation.
